Tech Bulletin: Updated Consumable View on The Well



On The Well, we're updating the way we display which consumables are out or about to be out at your machine. We're updating this to make the All Units page more scannable and easy to read, highlighting when things are out of stock at your machines, and not drawing attention when your machine doesn't need service. The places where this will be updated are detailed below:

The All Units Page

On the All Units page, the consumables will no longer look like a battery and instead will be written out and stacked. In addition to this, they will now only be highlighted in yellow or red*: yellow= out in 1-3 days, red=out or expired.

*Note: if you have the "Plan ahead view" checked on your summary view, consumables will also be highlighted yellow-green when they will be out or expired in 4 to 5 days.

The Unit Page

The Restock status section on the single Unit page has been updated to match what you see on the All Units page as well.



With the amount of information on the Unit page, this paired down view will make this page more digestible and easier to read, allowing you to dispatch service as quickly as possible.

The Restock Email

The final place this will be updated is your Service Alert email that you receive when something is out at your machines. Nothing has changed about the set up of this email, the only thing that is different is the email attachment, which has been updated to be consistent with the All Units and Single Unit Page.
